- Group I is the most difficult level of literature. If you have never participated in solo and ensemble, you will need to speak with a director for approval. (Ideal Grade 9-12). Students earning Gold in Div. 1 will advance to State on **Feb. 24**, so set that date aside.
- Group II is challenging music. A young, proficient musician that has performance experience at the freshman/sophomore level is a good candidate for this level. (Ideal Grade 9-12)
- Group III is for the growing musician wanting to experience performance in a judged event. Comments at this level are many times more nurturing towards the young players' advancement. (Ideal Grade 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>)
- Group IV is a reasonable group level for the student musician that has played from two to three years in an instrumental class. (Ideal Grade 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>)
- Group V is a reasonable group level for the student musician that has played less than one year. (Only for 6<sup>th</sup> Grade)

*Dear Orchestra Parents,*

Solo and Ensemble is being held this year at **Noblesville High School** on the above date. All students that are participating in **Private Lessons** are encouraged to participate in a solo or an ensemble or both. If your child decides to do a solo, private lessons are STRONGLY encouraged but not required. The student, with their **private teacher**, is responsible for obtaining a piano accompanist, if one is needed. We will also assist students in locating accompanists. **The cost is \$15.00 per solo and \$7.00 per student participating in ensembles.** A student is not permitted to perform two solos on the same instrument. Transportation to and from the site will be the parents' responsibility. Times and room schedules will be sent home as soon as we receive them (early to mid-January).

Please fill out the reverse side of this paper and return the form and the payment (it must be in an envelope labeled with your name and titled solo and ensemble) to your director by

**Friday, Nov. 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 by 3:15pm.**

**If you miss the entry deadline, you will not be registered or allowed to perform. This is an ISSMA rule!**

Each student must have the **original copy** of the score, with measures numbered to give to the judge. The student can play from a photocopy, but the judge must have the **original copy** with all measures numbered. **The student's private teacher will get this original score to them.** Without the score, a student will automatically receive a division rating lower. Mr. Powell will give *ensembles only* their original score. Please dress by wearing the **orchestra uniform**. Students should bring extra strings, rosin, and any other items needed.
